


Double Trouble State Park



Cedar Creek Canoe & Kayak Access Areas



There are three access locations in the state park: at Dover Forge off Dover Road/CR 618; at Ore Pond off Pinewald-Keswick Road/CR 618; and at the White Bridge in Double Trouble Village. Parking is available near the creek at Dover Forge and Ore Pond. The White Bridge Cedar Creek Access location at Double Trouble Village is restricted to walk-in use. Canoes and kayaks must be carried to the White Bridge from the Village parking area, a distance of approximately 1/4 of a mile. Vehicles are not permitted to drive through Double Trouble Village. Tubing, rafting and swimming are prohibited at Double Trouble State Park. Canoes and kayaks are not available for rent at the park. Downstream of the Garden State Parkway bridge is outside Double Trouble State Park – local ordinances apply.
